Codiac Transpo's Bike and Ride system encourages cyclists to combine cycling with public transit by providing you with more active transportation choices where you work, live and play.

Environmentally-friendly transportation alternatives combine the love of cycling and the convenience of Codiac Transpo's conventional route service.

With a bike rack installed on every bus, it's never been easier for cyclist to travel around Greater Moncton and beyond. There is no additional fare for transporting your bike.

The bike rack is fast and simple to use.

- Before the bus arrives, remove loose items from your bicycle, water bottles, saddlebags, carriers or any non-permanent fixture as well as items that would limit the drivers view.
- Alert the Bus Operator of your intention to use the bike rack.
- From a safe area – approach the bus from the curb side.
- Load your bike after other passenger bikes have been unloaded.
- Always load bicycle into the bike rack space closest to the front of the bus outward.
- You are responsible to secure your bike properly.

LOADING



- 1 Hold your bike with one hand and squeeze the bike rack's handle and lower the rack.

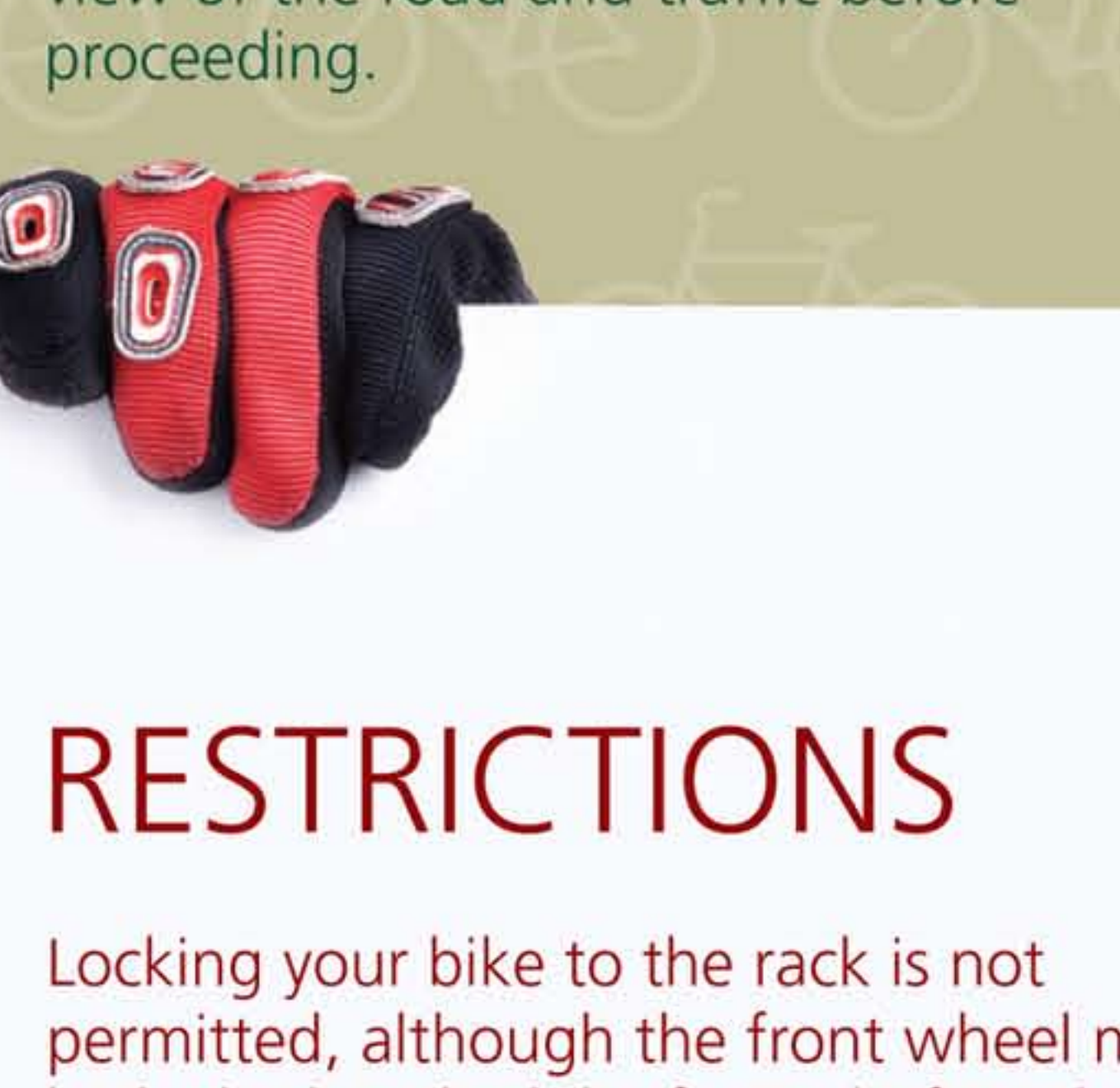
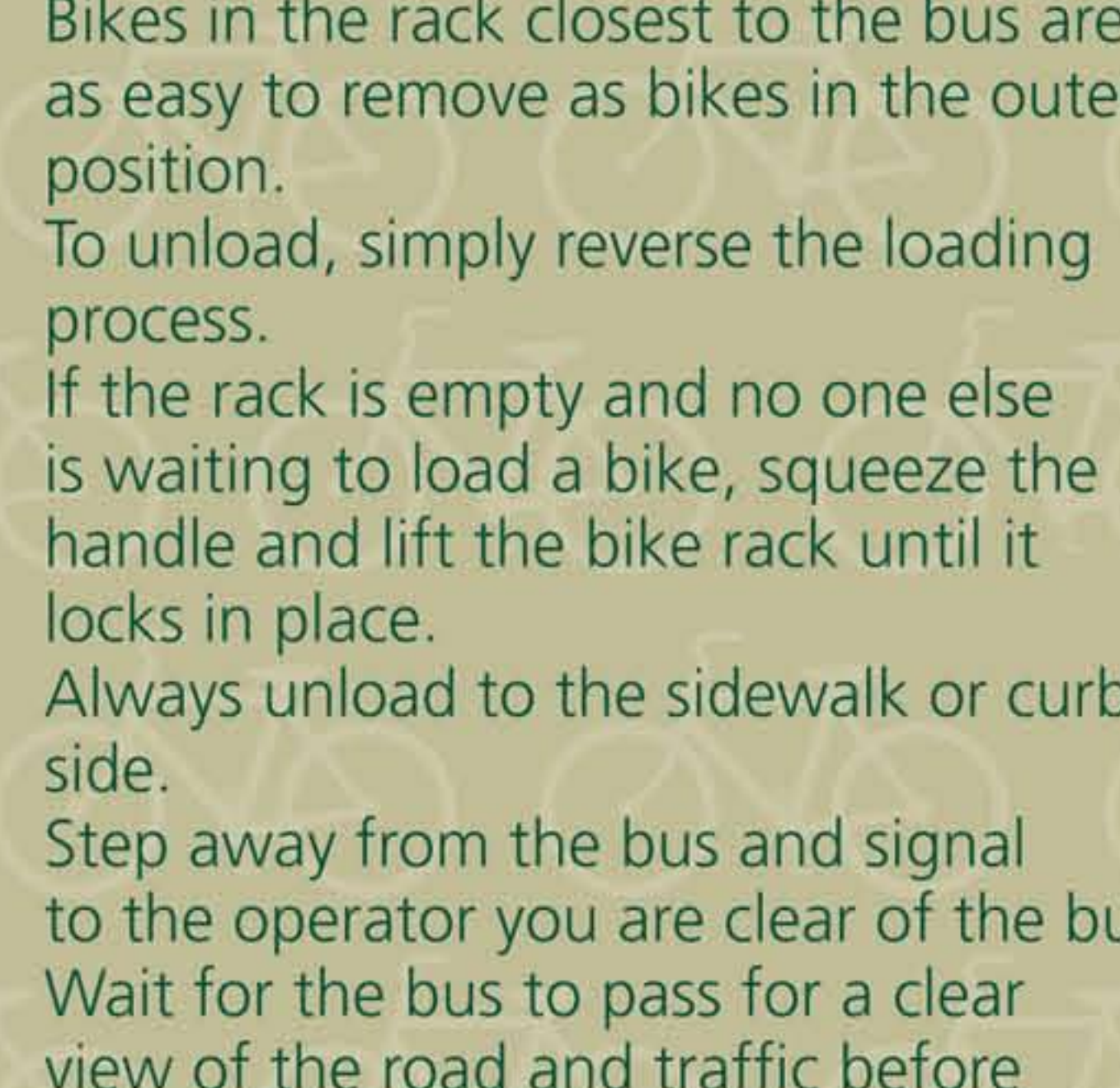


- 2 Lift your bicycle onto the rack, ensuring that both the front and rear tires are positioned in the wheel slots. A label will tell you where the front wheel should go.

- 3 After the bike is in position, pull the tire arm hook out and lift the hook to rest at the highest point of the wheel.



To use the bike racks, children under 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.



UNLOADING

1. Advise the operator you are leaving the bus one stop in advance.
2. Bikes in the rack closest to the bus are as easy to remove as bikes in the outer position.
3. To unload, simply reverse the loading process.
4. If the rack is empty and no one else is waiting to load a bike, squeeze the handle and lift the bike rack until it locks in place.
5. Always unload to the sidewalk or curb side.
6. Step away from the bus and signal to the operator you are clear of the bus.
7. Wait for the bus to pass for a clear view of the road and traffic before proceeding.



RESTRICTIONS

- Locking your bike to the rack is not permitted, although the front wheel may be locked to the bike frame before the bus arrives.
- The tire-arm hook will support standard two-wheel bikes with 16 inch (41 cm) to 29 inch (73.66 cm) wheels. Motorized or electric bicycles, tandem or recumbent style or tricycles are not suitable for this bike rack.
- Codiac Transpo is not responsible for damages incurred or caused by or to bicycles, or for lost or stolen bicycles.
- Codiac operators cannot abandon the bus to assist passengers to load or unload bikes.
